We are writing to inform you of two out of hours deliveries we will be having this week. Both are wide loads that have a Police Movement Order applied to them, which prevents them from travelling on the public road network at peak hours.

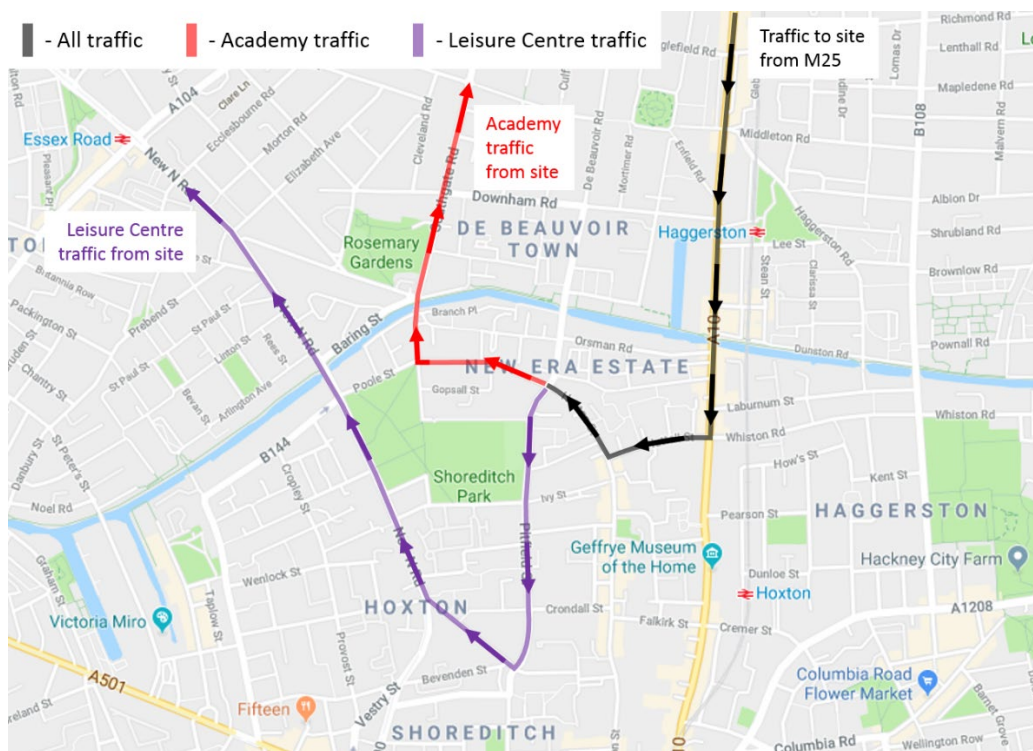
1. Wednesday 11 September am – Britannia Leisure Centre crane

We will have a large mobile crane arrive on site at 6am. This will arrive through the site gates off Grange Street just after 6am where it will pull up, turn its engine off and wait until 8am before moving and setting up.

2. Wednesday 11 September pm – School project

At 6pm we will have one of the large excavator collected from the school project. The collection vehicle will arrive in Northport Street just after 6pm. It will manoeuvre into our site gate off Northport Street which will take a couple of minutes. The excavator will be loaded on to the collection vehicle within the site footprint before the vehicle drives out of the gates on Northport Street and leave site via the agreed logistics route.

We would also like to let you know that as of Wednesday 11 September we will have completed our combined services trench installation on Pitfield Street. From Wednesday 11 September we will reopen Pitfield Street for construction vehicles to leave our project and revert to the agreed logistics route via New North Road to leave our site. As a reminder the route is shown below.
