## Pressing ahead...

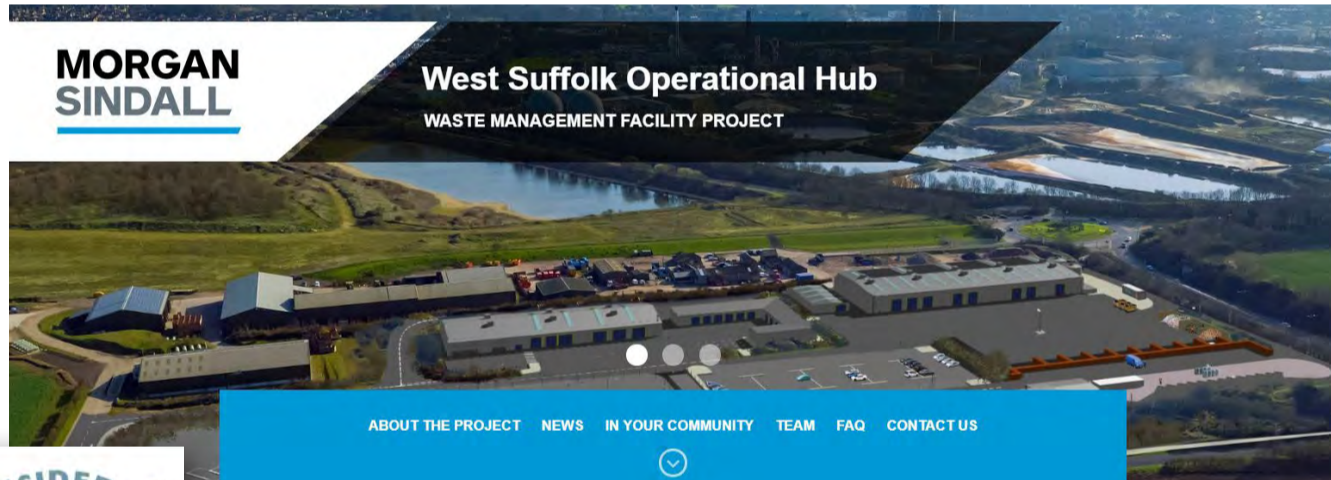
Welcome back to Dear Neighbour, our newsletter that keeps you updated on West Suffolk Operational Hub, Bury St Edmunds.

We've had another month of heightened activity. The groundworks are continuing to progress around the site, with drainage (installation of both foul and rainwater run-off drains), foundations, concrete, steelwork securing bolts and formation of sloping ground around the perimeter to facilitate the permanent fencing installation.

We are preparing to receive the first load of steelwork in October for the construction of the vehicle maintenance workshop. This construction will be followed by exterior cladding works in the coming months. We are approximately halfway through the piling installation with around another 150 no. to complete! This will then release further areas for additional steelwork.

We intend to hold future events such as open afternoons and talks regarding the works; which will be noted in our next newsletter. The project has now been registered as an Ultra Site under the Considerate Constructors Scheme. The project will be monitored and scored on how well it complies to the requirements set out by the schemes code of conduct. This focuses on the appearance, the community, site safety, the environment and the workforce.
