Welcome back to Dear Neighbour, our newsletter that keeps you updated on West Suffolk Operational Hub, Bury St Edmunds.

Another month of heightened activity! The steelwork to the depot and workshop building has been completed, and the waste transfer station frame has just commenced.

Various additional groundworks activities are being continued such as the works to the access road which is shared with the local farmer, drainage across the entirety of the project and kerb / level build-ups in readiness for hard-standings.

Cladding to the depot and workshop building has started, we are aiming to have the roof on by Christmas! Cladding will then progress on to the waste transfer station.

Over the last few weeks you would have seen that the first phase of the Barton Hill foul drainage installation has been commenced and has gone well. We hope that the works have caused minimal disruption to yourselves and we will continue to monitor this throughout the second phase.

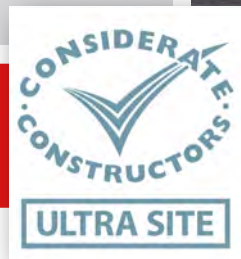
